Crochet Ripple Scarf

Debbie Bliss

SIZE

Approximately 7 x 168cm/2³/₄ x 66in

MATERIALS

One 50g ball of Debbie Bliss Luxury Silk DK in each of Fruit Salad 45 (A) and Buttermilk 14 (B).
3.5mm/E4 crochet hook.

ABBREVIATIONS

ch = chain stitch: yarn over hook, pull through stitch on hook.

dc/sc = UK double crochet/US single crochet: insert hook & pull up a loop, yarn over and pull through 2 loops on hook.

dtr/trc = UK double treble/US treble crochet: yarn over hook 2 times & pull up a loop (4 loops on hook), yarn over and pull through 2 loops on hook (3 times).

rep = repeat.

sl st = slip stitch: insert hook, yarn over hook and pull through both loops on hook.

st(s) = stitch(es).

tr/dc = UK treble crochet/US double crochet: yarn over hook, insert hook & pull up loop (3 loops on hook), yarn over hook, pull through 2 loops on hook (2 times).

tr/dc 2tog = UK treble crochet 2 together/US double crochet 2 together: yarn over hook, insert hook and pull up loop (3 loops on hook), yarn over hook pull through 2 loops on hook, leave 2 loops on hook and repeat in next st. There are now 4 loops on hook, yarn over hook, pull through all 4 loops on hook.

TO MAKE

With 3.5mm (US E/4) crochet hook and A, make 291 ch.

Work in ripple patt as follows:

1st row 1 tr/dc into 4th ch from hook, tr/dc into next ch, * 1 tr/dc into each of next 2 ch. [tr/dc 2tog] 4 times, 1 tr/dc into each of next 2 ch, [2 tr/dc into next ch] 4 times; rep from * ending last repeat with [2 tr/dc into next ch] 2 times.

2nd row Working in front half of each st only, ch 3, 1 tr/dc in same st, 2 tr/dc into next st, * 1 tr/dc into each of next 2 sts, [tr/dc 2tog] 4 times, 1 tr/dc into each of next 2 sts, [2 tr/dc into next sts] 4 times; rep from *, ending last repeat with (2 tr/dc into next st) 2 times.

3rd row Change to B and work as 2nd row in back half of sts only.

Rep 2nd and 3rd rows once more and break off yarn.

By working into only the front or back of the sts you will have created lines on the front of the scarf, with A, sl st along these lines and into every st on the last row, the effect will be very fine contrasting stripes. Sew in all yarn ends.

FLOWER (make 2)

With 3.5mm (US E/4) crochet hook and Fruit Salad make a sliding loop (alternatively work 6 ch and sl st together to make a loop)

1st row 12 tr/dc into ring. Pull sliding loop tight.

2nd row 4 ch, 6 dtr/ into same st, 4 ch then sl st into same st, (1st petal made), * sl st into next 2 tr/dc, [4 ch, 6 dtr/ into same st, 4 ch then sl st into same st]; rep from * until 6 petals made, ending last repeat with sl st into next st.

Using yarn ends from flowers, sew one to each end of the scarf.
